13:00 - 15:00 Field visit in the Murighiol area, by boats, weather permitting

The visit will provide an opportunity to observe:

- local fishing gear and fishing practices;
- the surrounding area connected to one of the Danube branches;
- migration-relevant zones for sturgeons;
- the local context of sturgeon migration during this period, as spring is an important season for migration related to spawning.
